This supplement (the **Supplement**) constitutes a third supplement to and must be read in conjunction with the Base Prospectus dated 15 July 2021 as supplemented by the first supplement dated 11 August 2021 and the second supplement dated 16 November 2021 (together, the **Base Prospectus**), prepared by Cofiroute (the **Issuer** or **Cofiroute**) with respect to the Euro 6,000,000,000 Euro Medium Term Note Programme (the **Programme**). Terms defined in the Base Prospectus have the same meaning when used in this Supplement.

This Supplement has been approved by the *Commission de Surveillance du Secteur Financier* (the **CSSF**) as competent authority under Regulation (EU) 2017/1129 (the **Prospectus Regulation**) and the Luxembourg Law dated 16 July 2019 relating to prospectuses for securities, as may be amended from time to time (the **Prospectus Law**).

To the best of the knowledge of the Issuer, the information contained in this Supplement is in accordance with the facts and contains no omission likely to affect its import. The Issuer accepts responsibility for the information contained in this Supplement.

This Supplement has been prepared pursuant to Article 23.1 of the Prospectus Regulation for the purposes of (i) incorporating by reference the English language translation of the Issuer's annual financial report as at 31 December 2021, which includes the audited individual financial statements of the Issuer for the year ended 31 December 2021, together with the explanatory notes and the free English language translation of the auditors' report (the **2021 Financial Report**), (ii) updating the "Recent Developments" section of the Base Prospectus by incorporating the new information set out below (the **New Information**), (iii) updating the "General Information" section of the Base Prospectus and (iv) updating the registered office of the Issuer in the Base Prospectus.

The 2021 Financial Report has been filed with the CSSF and by virtue of this Supplement it shall be deemed to be incorporated by reference into the section entitled "Documents Incorporated By Reference" on page 32 of the Base Prospectus and shall form part of the Base Prospectus.

To the extent that there is any inconsistency between any statement in this Supplement and any other statement in or incorporated in the Base Prospectus, the statements in this Supplement will prevail.

There has been no other significant new factor, material mistake or material inaccuracy relating to information included or incorporated in the Base Prospectus which is material in the context of the Programme since the publication of the Base Prospectus.

Annual Financial Information:

As at 31 December 2021, Cofiroute's total revenue increased by 19.4 per cent. to €1,438¹ million.

Price increase in 2022:

Toll rates on the A86 Duplex increased on 1 January 2022 pursuant to the Interministerial Decree of 27 December 2021.

Toll rates for the intercity network increased on 1 February 2022 pursuant to the Concession Contract. The average rise in the rate per kilometre is +1.90%.

Dividends:

On 18 March 2022, the Shareholders' General Meeting approved the Cofiroute 2021 individual financial statements and the payment of a dividend of €138.73 per share in respect of the financial year ending 2021, amounting to €563,037,925. Taking into account the interim dividend of €21.04 per share paid in August 2021, the remaining dividend to be paid in March 2022 is €117.69 per share, amounting to €477,646,748.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Paragraph (2) on page 148 in the "General Information" section of the Base Prospectus will be deleted and replaced with the following:

"(2) The Issuer has obtained all necessary consents, approvals and authorisations in France in connection with the update of the Programme. Any issuance of Notes under the Programme, to the extent that such Notes constitute obligations under French law, require the prior authorisation of the *Conseil d'administration* of the Issuer in accordance with Article L.228-40 of the French Commercial Code (*Code de commerce*). For this purpose the Board of Directors (*Conseil d'administration*) of the Issuer has delegated by a resolution passed on 28 January 2022 to Mr. Marc Bouron (*Directeur Général*) and to Mr. Frédéric Vautier (*Directeur Financier de VINCI Autoroutes*), all powers to issue obligations and to determine their Final Terms and conditions, up to a maximum aggregate amount of € 1,500,000,000 within a period of one year as from the date of such resolution. Any issuance of Notes, to the extent that such Notes do not constitute obligations under French law, fall within the general powers of the *Directeur Général* and the *Directeur Financier de VINCI Autoroutes*."

Paragraph (7) on page 148 in the "General Information" section of the Base Prospectus will be deleted and replaced with the following:

"(7) Save as disclosed in the "Recent Developments" section above, there has been no material adverse change in the prospects of the Issuer since 31 December 2021."

Paragraph (8) on page 148 in the "General Information" section of the Base Prospectus will be deleted and replaced with the following:

"(8) Save as disclosed in the "Recent Developments" section above, there has been no significant change in the financial position or financial performance of the Issuer or the Group since 31 December 2021."
